My teacher will then take the register and welcome everyone to class. We will look at the calendar and talk about our day.

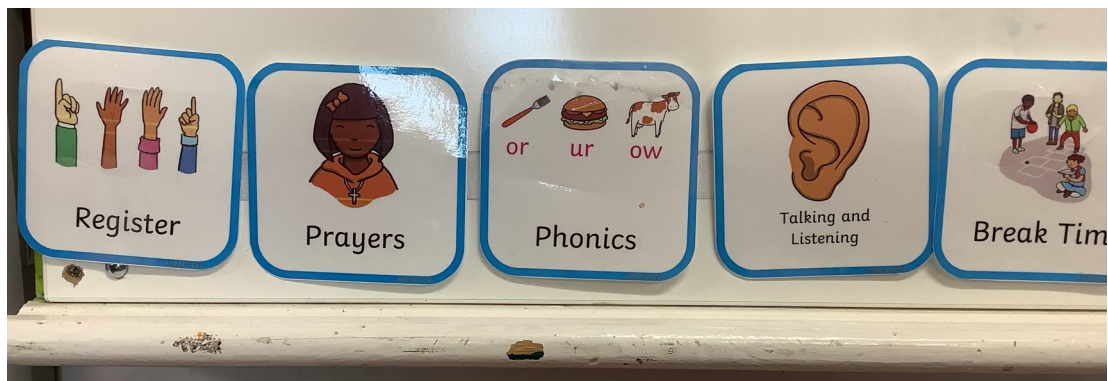


We will sit at our own desk, or on the carpet, when we do our register and welcome time together.

This is the role-play area in my classroom. It changes throughout the year and is a place where I can play with my friends.

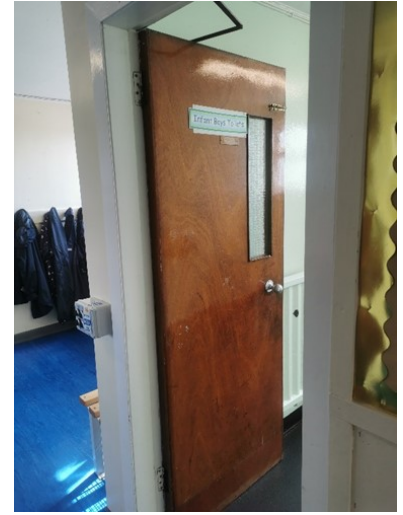


Here is the library area within my classroom. I can choose from lots of different books and read myself, to a friend or a cuddly toy.
